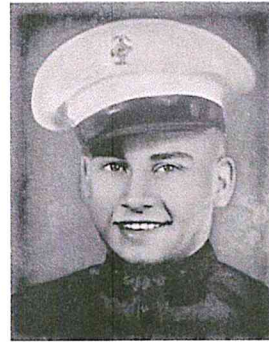


Who we are.....

Purple Heart - For Military Merit and for wounds received in action resulting in his death.

Charles C. Evering lost his life in action on June 24, 1944 at Saipan, Marianas Island

Birth: April 19, 1926

Death: June 24, 1944

Charles served as a Private First Class, 6th Marines, 2nd Marine Division, U. S. Marine Corps during World War II. He resided in Baltimore, Maryland prior to the war.

Charles was "Killed In Action" during the war and was awarded the Purple Heart.

Note: Entered the service from Maryland.

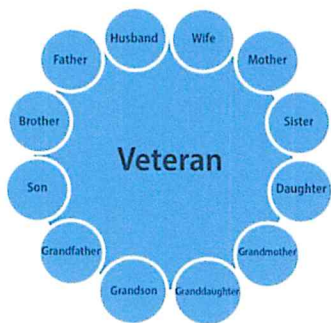
